Designation Combination Overview

GE Core Designations (AI, WR1, WR2, QL)

Lower Division

Cannot be combined with other designations

GE Breadth Area Designations (FF, HF, LS, PS, BF)

Lower Division

- May be combined with other Breadth Area designations but students will only receive credit toward one requirement area as determined by DARS based on need
- May be combined with certain Baccalaureate Degree Requirements (DV and IR) at the lower-division level
- Courses cannot carry more than two designations

Baccalaureate Degree Designations (DV, IR, CW, DI & QI)

Lower and Upper Division


- May be combined with other designations at the appropriate course level
 - DV and IR are unrestricted in course number and may be taught at any level
 - DV and IR may be combined with each other and any designation (other than the GE Core) at the appropriate course level
 - CW and the Methods Requirement designations (DI and QI) are upper division
 - CW may be combined with DI or QI
- Methods requirement designations (DI and QI) cannot be combined
- Courses cannot carry more than two designations

GE Core & Breadth Combinations




GE Core Designations
